The undersigned, if issued a license as herein requested, further agrees to obey all rules and regulations promulgated by the Board and the Code of the City of Tuscaloosa relative to all alcoholic beverages. The undersigned, if issued a license as herein requested, also agrees to allow and hereby invites duly authorized agents of the Alabama Alcoholic Beverage Control Board and any duly commissioned law enforcement officer of the State, County or Municipality in which the licensed premises are located to enter and search without a warrant the licensed premises or any building owned or occupied by him in connection with, adjoining, or adjacent thereto, whether connected or not, and whether used by him as his private dwelling or not, at any time. The undersigned understands that should he or she violate any of the provisions of Code of Alabama, Title 28, or any of the rules and regulations of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board, his license shall be subject to revocation. The undersigned understands that the City reserves the right to file for suspension, revocation or an objection with the Alabama Alcoholic Beverage Control Board to a license renewal for failure to follow the Alcoholic Beverage Control Laws of the State of Alabama and Code of Tuscaloosa or the creation of a nuisance. The undersigned further understands and agrees that no changes in the manner of operation, nature of owner and no deletion or discontinuance of any services or facilities as described in this application will be allowed without prior written approval of the City of Tuscaloosa and the Alabama Alcoholic Beverage Control Board.
